- A. TransLink Funds received. Numerous projects with expected completion timeline of 1 to 4 years.
- B. Planning department has neighbourhood concept plans. These plans show intended cycling facilities. Land Use Planning | City of Surrey Search the city website under concept plans for your neighbourhood.
- C. Bollards on off road greenways. Contact the City Parks department for this issue, not the engineering/transportation department.
- D. Signage update to TransLink standards.
- E. Quick build project. Numerous quick builds for cycling were done on 100 Ave, 132 Street and 108 Ave. City Parkway under construction. Whalley blvd done.
- F. King George application for federal/provincial funding. Support letters sent in on this issue. No word back on decisions.
- G. Budget/Inflation – Budget restraint and inflation cost impacting projects, delaying some.
- H. Transportation page on website- Transportation Division | City of Surrey this page outlines what the transportation department does. Email any concerns to transportation@surrey.ca Any concerns regarding baffle gates in neighbourhoods, contact the transportation department.
