#### **5.1. Meeting with City December 11 - Jenny (15)**

Stretch of Donovan - Donovan is already a neighborhood bike way and the city said they would put speed cushions. Committee feels it's already safe and this isn't really adding 3km to the bike network for a city that doesn't need it.

Jenny feels that 123rd should not be counted as this years 3km. Already in budget last year.
